NANDI COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2015

A BILL for an Act of the County Assembly of Nandi to enact laws relating to various fees, rates, charges and duties and taxes and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Nandi, as follows: -

- Short title.** 1. This Bill may be cited as the Nandi County Finance Bill, 2015.
- Power to make rules.** 2. The county executive member responsible for Finance and Economic planning & ICT may make rules generally for the better carrying out of the provisions and purposes of this Bill.
- Savings.** 3. (1) This section applies to any Act relating to business permits made by a local authority within the county if that Act was in force immediately before the commencement of this Bill.
- (2) On and after the commencement of this Bill, the Act continues in force as if:
- a) It had been made by the county government; and
 - b) A reference in the Act to a local authority were a reference to the county government; and
 - c) A reference in the Act to clerk, however described, were a reference to the licensing authority; and
 - d) Any fees or charges payable to the local authority were payable to the county government.
- (3) A business permit issued under the Act continues in force as if it were a trade license granted under this Bill by the county government.

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SCHEDULE 3- REVENUE RAISING MEASURES

1. Maximization of all revenue sources by tapping on untapped sources e.g. water bottling, Recreational areas and eco-tourism.
2. Enhancing legal framework through speedy making of relevant revenue laws.
3. Acquisition of a Revenue Collection System (Automation)
4. Regular departmental meetings to monitor and evaluate revenue performances.
5. Adherence to standards in levying of fees, rates, charges and duties e.g. use of standard forms in building and construction sector.
6. Improvement of service delivery as an incentive to tax payers.
7. Reduction of fees as a means to encourage many tax payers to pay.
8. Reduction on administrative cost on raising revenues.
9. Granting of a waiver on all penalties on land rates and rents.
